UMRCC FIELD TRIP GRANT PROGRAM



Purpose

This grant program is intended to assist schools and education-related non-profit organizations by funding field trips to the Mississippi or Illinois Rivers. Our goal is to connect students to nature and encourage a sense of stewardship of the Mississippi River.



Grant Information

Grants of up to \$500 are made to support the cost of a field trip, including substitute teacher and transportation.

Applications must be received at least 45 days prior to the trip. Recipients must submit receipts and a brief narrative report within 30 days following the trip.



Criteria

Field trip must be located along the Mississippi or Illinois Rivers in Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Illinois, or Missouri. Priority will be given to trips that include 15 participants or more; if group size is smaller, please contact the UMRCC Grant Coordinator.
